**Targets**

EU: 20% below 1990 by 2020 and 30% if other countries take on ambitious targets

Norway, Sweden, Germany, UK: 40% below 1990 by 2020

Japan and Australia: 25% below 1990 by 2020

US: (in case of Waxman- Markey): 17% below 1990 by 2020

**Federal Target: 3% below 1990 by 2020**

Quebec: 20% below 1990 by 2020

Ontario: 15% below 1990 by 2020

BC: 33% below 2007 by 2020 = 14% below 1990

Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Newfoundland, PEI: 10% below 1990 by 2020

Manitoba: 6% below 1990 by 2012

Saskatchewan: 20% below 2006 by 2020

Alberta: Increase of 58% ABOVE 1990 by 2020 (stabilize there)
